

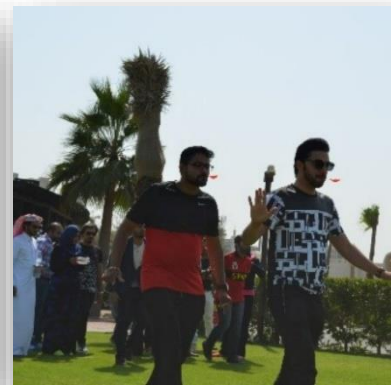
Crazy Race

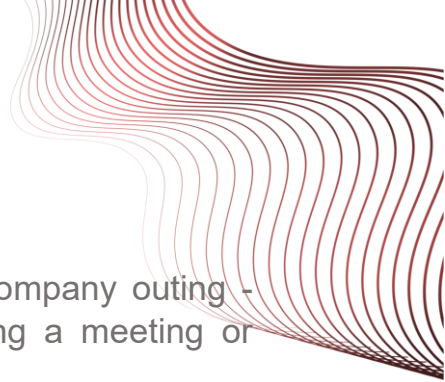
How it Works:
