### How it Works:

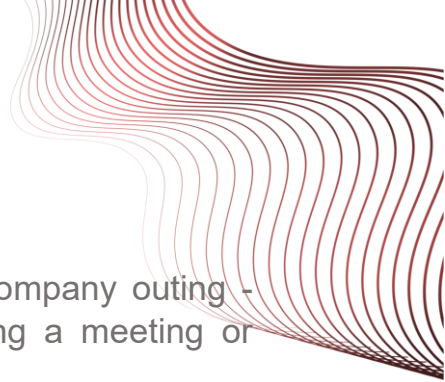
