Teams work with various beneficiaries such as orphanages, schools, and communities in need. The specific projects are tailored to the beneficiary's current needs and the client's requirements.

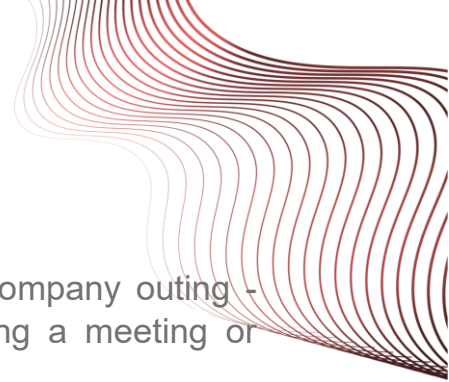
