How it Works:

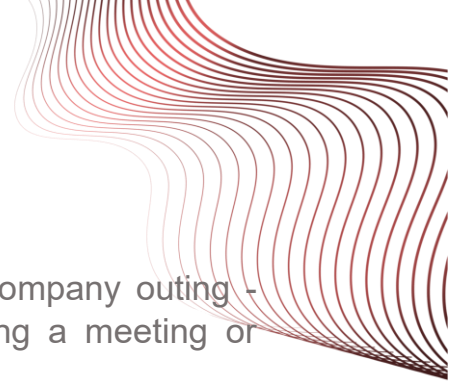
