

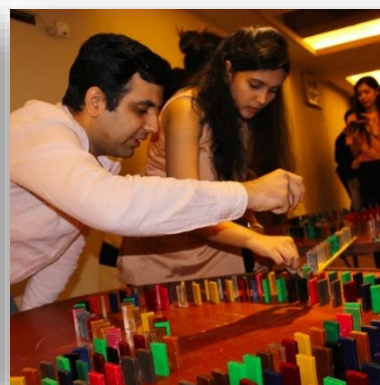
Domino Rally

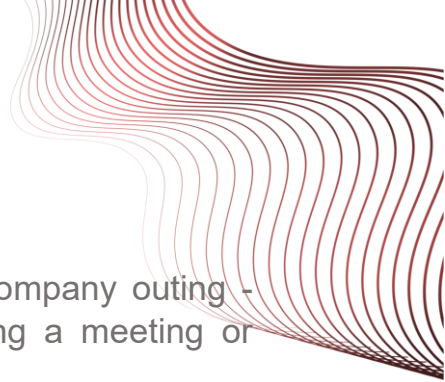
How it Works:
