Marble Run Chain

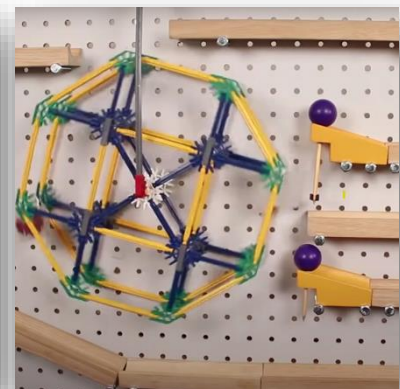
Unlock the secrets of teamwork and innovation as you construct a captivating marble run like no other!

How it Works:

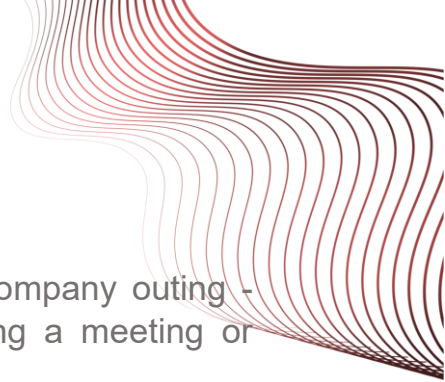
