Imagine that your team has experienced a simulated plane crash in a remote wilderness area. The crash has left you "stranded," and your primary objective is to survive until rescue arrives. This scenario sets the stage for a challenging and immersive wilderness survival experience.

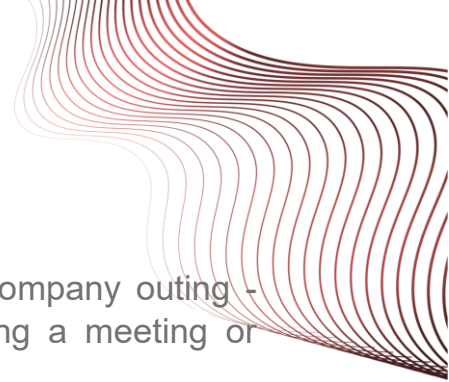
How it Works:

In the aftermath of a plane crash, your team must locate and secure food and water in the wilderness by identifying edible plants, fruits, nuts, and other safe-to-consume options while rationing supplies for rescue. Constructing a sturdy shelter using branches, leaves, tarpaulin, ropes, and available materials is critical for protection from the elements and maintaining body heat. To increase the chances of being rescued, your team must collaboratively devise visible SOS signs and sound-based distress signals with whistles, horns, or noise-making objects. This immersive wilderness survival experience not only challenges participants but also enhances teamwork and the team-building aspect of the activity.
