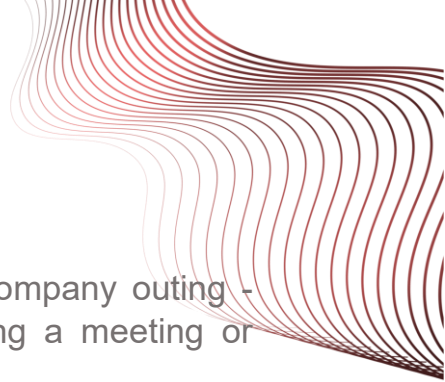
#### How it Works:
