

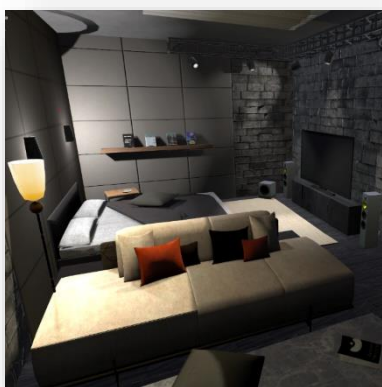
Escape Room

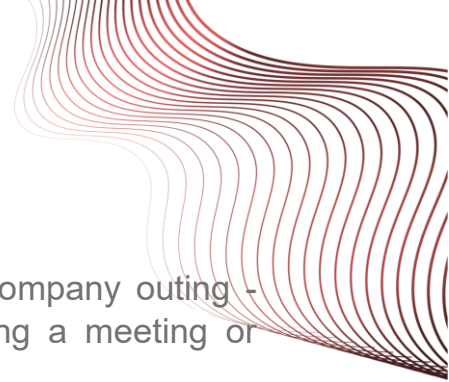
How it Works:
