# **Beach Clean Up**

#### Team up, restore the coast, and leave a lasting environmental legacy.

Beach Clean-Up is a collaborative and rewarding activity that brings together a group of individuals to help clean and restore a beach in need. Participants work alongside local community members, removing litter and potentially installing new trash cans to prevent future pollution. This event fosters teamwork, community engagement, and environmental consciousness, while providing a sense of accomplishment and fulfilment.

#### How it Works:

Participants meet at the designated beach location and receive a briefing from the lead facilitator. They are divided into teams and given clear instructions and objectives for the clean-up activity. Collaborating with the local community, teams work diligently to clean the beach, fostering teamwork, and community spirit. After the clean-up, a debriefing session allows participants to reflect on their performance, and if there was a team competition, the winning team is recognized and awarded for their efforts.
